Assistant County Commissioner - Communications

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ROLE?

To support the Deputy County Commissioner (Adult Support) in leading the delivery of Communications across the County.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

Deputise for the DCC Adult Support where appropriate

Work with the County & District Commissioners and members of the County Team to review & agree the ongoing strategy for the delivery of communications within the County.

Lead on the recruitment of suitable Managers to the County Comms Team, and ensure they receive appropriate induction, training, ongoing support and supervision.

Work with the County & District Teams to develop and maintain effective communications for Leaders.

ANYTHING ELSE?

Meet with members of the Communications Team, under your care, regularly to ensure that they receive the support they need and are effective in their role.

Meet with each member of the Communications Team, under your care, to carry out an annual review of their contribution to Scouting and their ongoing performance of the role.
