ROLE DESCRIPTION

ASSISTANT COUNTY COMMISSIONER PROGRAMME 6-14

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ROLE?

To lead the delivery of programme support by the County Team to the Beaver, Cub and Scout sections.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

Work with the District Beaver, Cub and Scout Programme Teams to identify what programme support activities and events the County Team need to deliver.

Lead the recruitment of suitable County Leaders to deliver programme support events and activities and ensure they receive appropriate induction and training.

Supervise and support County Leaders involved in the delivery of programme support events and activities.

ANYTHING ELSE?

Meet with members of the County Programme Team regularly to ensure that they receive the support they need and are effective in their role.

Meet with each member of the County Programme Team, under your care, to carry out an annual review of their contribution to Scouting and their ongoing performance of the role.
