ROLE DESCRIPTION

COUNTY TRAINING MANAGER

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ROLE?

To lead the County Training Team in delivering Adult Training.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

Work with the County & District Commissioners to review & agree the ongoing strategy for the delivery of Adult learning opportunities within the County.

Lead on the recruitment of suitable Leaders to the County Training Team and ensure they receive appropriate induction, training, ongoing support and supervision.

Work with County Adult Appointments Committee to maintain effective communication so that new members of the County Team are assigned a Training Adviser as soon as possible.

Work with the County Training Team to ensure that administration relevant to learning / training is completed efficiently and effectively.

Work with the County Training Team to ensure that Wood Badges are recommended in a timely and efficient manner.

Work with other CTMs to share ideas and support the development of training.

ANYTHING ELSE?

Meet with members of the County Training Team, under your care, regularly to ensure that they receive the support they need and are effective in their role.

Meet with each member of the County Training Team, under your care, to carry out an annual review of their contribution to Scouting and their ongoing performance of the role.
